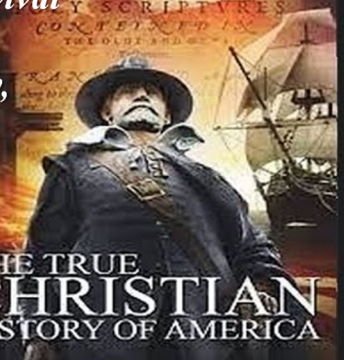

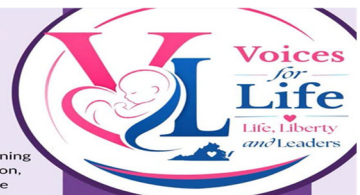
Join us for an inspiring evening of community, conversation, and purpose as we come together to celebrate the dignity and value of every human life.

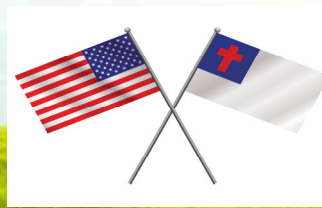
