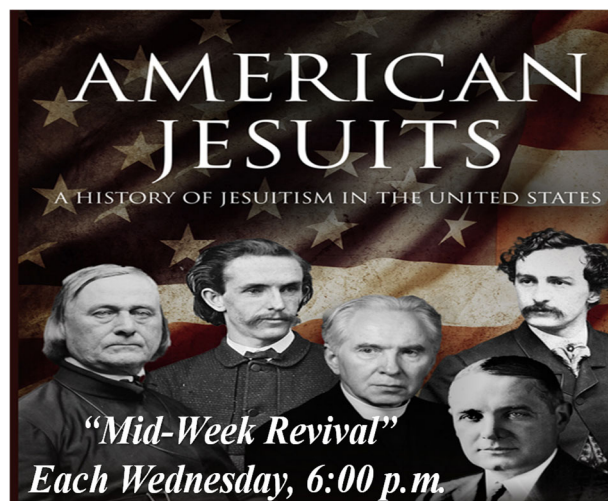


Please note the "Tax Free" Shopping Days chart. This is part of our "Christmas in July" preparation for "Operation Christmas Child".

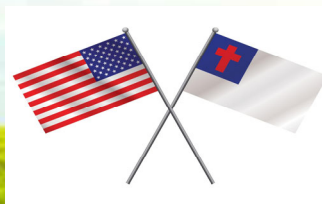
