Speaking of which, morning's message will focus specifically on fellowship and relationships as we continue our four-week study entitled, "Cadence".


If you are visiting with us today, thank you for being such an important part of our fellowship and please plan on returning. Above all, we pray you receive an encouragement from worshipping with us today.
